STEP 1

RE-REGISTRATION SERVICE

The re-registration will be managed to the participants and accompanying persons at **COACH BAY, Terminal 3 - Changi Airport Singapore** upon arrival times from 06.30 until 13.00 on 02 December 2011.

Cruise Facility for Early Boarding

Boarding time is since **11.00**. Participants whose boarding earlier may use the cruise facility automatically once on board, i.e. Lunch. *Boarding will be closed at 14.00.*

Passport Collection

Participant shall follow the lane and signage embarking to the ship. Cruise staff will collect each guest *Passport & Immigration Card* before boarding to the ship, however the mentioned documents will be delivered back after the sailing ended.

Boarding

Guest will need to pass through vessel security screening and crew personnel will swap the SeaPass Card prior to boarding, as well as making picture for passenger's presence onboard.

Passage General Briefing

STEP 3

CASHLESS SYSTEM WITH SEAPASS CARD ONBOARD

SeaPass Card is used for all purchases of passengers' items of nature (personal expenses), except those few that require cash, i.e. bar service, foreign exchange and casino. The balance will be billed to the personal credit card of passengers' choice or cash, at the end of cruise (in USD that converted into IDR).

Disembarking During Your Cruise

Please bring along your **SeaPass Card** to disembark and embark from the cruise ship at any Port-Of-Call during the Shore Excursion journey. ***SeaPass Card must be taken care and may not be lost.***

STEP 4

DISEMBARKING PROCEDURE

Passport Recollection

The Cruise Director will announce the meeting point and time to collect your Passport on 3rd day of the sailing. The detail venue will be attached in ***Cruise Compass*** –which is delivered daily in every cabin.

You may collect your passport by presenting your SeaPass Card. If you want to collect passports on behalf of your family and friends, you need to have their SeaPass Cards. Children who have their own passport or identification document and who cannot sign must be accompanied by their guardian / parents.

Baggage Assistance

Should you require assistance to unload your baggage from the ship, please leave your baggage with name clearly written on the *color Luggage Tag* you prior received at outside of your cabin door on the last night of cruise.

Your luggage will be collected and delivered to the **Luggage Collection Area** of the Singapore Cruise Center as the disembarkation.

Disembarkation Time

To make your disembarkation as smooth as possible, guests with Luggage Tags will be ushered out in staggered groups by various times scheduled. Please gather at your designated waiting area to await your turn to disembark.

However, participant without Luggage Tags and assistance needs may proceed as **EXPRESS DEPARTURE** to Deck 4 at the soonest departure time on 07.15 morning.

Ice Water

Mineral water in the cabin is charged upon your personal account.

Here you will also have a photograph opportunity of the Queen Victoria Fountain, Tan Beng Swee Clock Tower, Christ Church as well as some time for souvenir shopping.

The Stadthuys houses the Museum of History and Ethnography that you will visit to see the Dutch Governor's Dining Room and the Dutch Bakery.

Walking up St. Paul's Hill, you will see the ruins of the St. Paul's Church where St. Francis Xavier, a famous missionary, was briefly buried in 1553. Coming down the hill to Porta de Santiago, the hallmark of Malacca, one of the most photographed sites, the built by the Portuguese as a fortress.

After the commentary by the guide, you will visit the wooden replica of the Malacca Sultan's Palace, built with great detail and refinement.
